

# Learning in Action

### A week of PE

This week in PE, Reception class have been working on travelling safely around the room in different ways such as walking, skipping, hopping, etc. They have also been reacting to the whistle to find a space and demonstrate a jump into a hoop.

Y1, Y1/2 and Y2 have been practicing ball skills by rolling the ball at a target and defending a rolling ball.

Y3, Y3/4 and Y4 have been developing their basketball skills including shooting practice, attacking, and defending in teams, whilst learning to intercept.

Y5, Y5/6 and Y6 have been focusing on badminton this week. They have been learning to target a serve to a place on the court, using fore hand and back hand swings. They have also used different methods to return a shot.
