

Year 1/2


Year 1/2 have been busy this week. In maths, they have been finding one more and one less than given numbers.



QUEST PARENT COMMUNICATION AT OUR SCHOOL

We work very hard to communicate effectively with our parents and carers. We believe that strong communication between home and school is essential for the success of our children. This overview outlines how we communicate with parents and encourage a positive relationship in your child's education.

Below are the various methods in how you contact staff members in school as well as how we communicate important information and dates to parents. Please be aware that we will endeavour to provide same day responses wherever possible. However, due to staff availability and scheduling, this cannot be guaranteed.



Class Dojo is our main communication with parents. The direct message function can be used to send messages to the administration team who will ensure this reaches the appropriate staff member in a timely manner. Where appropriate, individual letters will also be sent via this function. Class story will also be used to share reminders of any events or information that is specific to the class. School story will be used to share the school newsletter and any whole school information as well as to advertise school and local community events/theme days.



Please call 01942 703465 if you wish to speak to the administration team directly. The team will pass on any messages to the relevant staff and arrange appointments as appropriate.
